- (b) That Mendez Taxi be required to submit to the police department a complete list of its drivers and that Hanford Police Department confirm that all drivers hold driver permits; and
- (c) That suspension of their business permit should continue if these conditions are not satisfied at the end of the sixty (60) day suspension.
