ROLL CALL BY THE CITY CLERK:

Mayor Gary Pannett called the meeting to order at 7:17 p.m.

The invocation was led by Floyd Burrus. Mayor Pannett asked that Les Collins be remembered during this time.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Chuck Jelloian, Corcoran, gave an update on the police funding project he has been working on with the police chiefs of Hanford, Corcoran, Lemoore, and Avenal. He asked City Council to contact their Assemblyman in favor of the project. In a few days, he should know where the project stands. Council asked him to report updates once a month, either during Public Comment or via email to the City Manager.

- A.** Community Development: Waive the second reading and approve Ordinance 14-02 adopting Municipal Code Amendment 2014-03 adding Section 17.44.065 to the Zoning Ordinance pertaining to large automobile dealership signage.

3. PUBLIC HEARING:

- A.** Finance Department: Public Hearing regarding the Application and a Resolution to issue a Permit to Operate two additional "Automobiles For Hire" Filed by Jose Cabrera DBA Limo One

Mayor Pannett opened the Public Hearing and called for the staff report. Finance Director Dibble presented the staff report and recommended adoption of the Resolution. Mayor Pannett invited questions of staff. Councilmember IRWIN asked if there are any hidden fees, such as mileage or service fees. Finance Director Dibble replied that there are no additional fees. Mayor Pannett opened Public Comment. There was none. Closed Public Comment.

Motion to adopt Resolution 14-27-R by :Joleen Jameson/Jim Irwin. Passed. 5-0. Ayes: Curry , Irwin , Jameson , Martinez , Pannett .

- B.** Community Development: Continue the public hearing started on April 1, 2014, and approve resolution 14-09-R, increasing building inspection and plan review fees.

Mayor Pannett opened the Public Hearing and called for the staff report. Building Official Tom Webb presented the staff report. Mayor Pannett opened Public Comment, and hearing none, closed Public Comment.

Motion to adopt Resolution 14-09-R by :Lou Martinez/Joleen Jameson. Passed. 5-0. Ayes: Curry , Irwin , Jameson , Martinez , Pannett .

- C.** Community Development: Hold a public hearing and provide direction for the development of the City's FY 2014-2018 Community Development Block Grant Consolidated Plan, the first year's Annual Action Plan and Amendment to the Citizen Participation Plan.

Mayor Pannett opened the Public Hearing and called for the staff report. Housing Specialists Lori Saldaña and Sandra Lerma-Martinez presented the staff report and a proposed distribution of grant monies. Jeff, KCAO and Savino Perico, both with KCAO, spoke in favor of their after-school program. Mothers/Guardians Leah, Dasha, Ronelle, and Amy spoke of how the program helps their children and provides safe after-school care for them. Some of the children spoke, as well. Mayor Pannett closed the public hearing.

Motion to approve the proposed distribution by :Jim Irwin/Joleen Jameson. Passed. 5-0. Ayes: Curry , Irwin , Jameson , Martinez , Pannett .

- D.** Community Development: Hold a public hearing and introduce and waive the first reading of Ordinance 14-03 for Municipal Code Amendment 2014-05, an amendment to Section 17.18.090 of the Hanford Municipal Code to increase the maximum building coverage from 40 percent to 45 percent.

Mayor Pannett opened the Public Hearing and called for the staff report. Planning Consultant Mata presented the staff report and recommended approval. Mayor Pannett opened the Public Comment: One of the applicants, Jim Robinson with San Joaquin Valley Homes, addressed the Council and encouraged approval. Mayor Pannett closed Public Comment.

Motion to introduce and waive the first reading of Ordinance 14-03 by :Lou Martinez/Joleen Jameson. Passed. 5-0. Ayes: Curry , Irwin , Jameson , Martinez , Pannett .

- E.** Police Department: Hold the public hearing and approve the use of the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) for FY 2014 as proposed.

Mayor Pannett opened the Public Hearing and called for the staff report. Planning Consultant Mata presented the staff report and recommended approval. Mayor Pannett opened Public Comment, and receiving none, closed Public Comment.

Motion to introduce and waive the first reading of Ordinance 14-04 by :Jim Irwin/Joleen Jameson. Passed. 5-0. Ayes: Curry , Irwin , Jameson , Martinez , Pannett .

- F.** Community Development: Hold a public hearing and introduce and waive the first reading of Ordinance 14-04 for Municipal Code Amendment No. 2014-06, a request by the City of Hanford to amend Section 17.66.020 deleting paragraph C and adding Section 17.02.070 Multiple Decisions.

Mayor Pannett opened the Public Hearing and called for the staff report. Police Captain Parker Sever presented the staff report and recommended approval. The proposed use of the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) for FY 2014 is body-worn cameras "Taser Cam." Mayor Pannett opened Public Comment, and receiving none, closed Public Comment.

Motion to approve the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant as proposed by :Russ Curry/Lou Martinez. Passed. 5-0. Ayes: Curry , Irwin , Jameson , Martinez , Pannett .

Comments: 1) Would like to recognize the Hanford Chamber of Commerce for all they are doing for the City of Hanford and efforts put forth to bring back the Fourth of July celebration to Hanford High School this year; 2) Would like to recognize Craig Miller, Parks and Recreation Director, for the great job he is doing for that department.
