CALL TO ORDER:

Following dinner, Mayor David Ayers called the joint meeting to order at 5:47 p.m.

FLAG SALUTE:

Mayor Ayers led the flag salute.

INTRODUCTIONS:

Staff, Board Members, and City Council made self-introductions.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Any person may directly address the Boards and Council at this time on any item on the agenda, or on any item that is within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Boards and Council. A maximum of five minutes is allowed for each speaker.

There were no comments given.

CITY OF HANFORD:

A. Fire Station No. 3 Construction Project - Darrel Pyle, City Manager

City Manager Darrel Pyle provided an overview of the proposed project and the benefits to the new location. Fire Chief Chris Ekk discussed the review process to prepare for a contract to be awarded tonight by the City Council. He described the various features in the proposed facility and responded to questions and comments by the Board Members and City Council.

COLLEGE OF THE SEQUOIAS:

A. Hanford Center Enrollment Update/Vocational Update

Superintendent Stan Carrizosa distributed a Community Report on the Sequoias Community College District and a booklet on Career Technical Education.

Kristin Robinson, Provost, provided an update on the current enrollment on full time equivalent students and the programs available at the COS Hanford campus. She briefly discussed public transportation opportunities to attend any of the campuses.

B. Hanford Center Facility/Expansion

Superintendent Stan Carrizosa discussed their expansion projects including the Hanford Student Quad and the Hanford Classroom Modular which are scheduled for construction this year.

C. COS/Fresno State Update

Superintendent Stan Carrizosa stated that the building is complete in Visalia for Fresno State to move in. He was pleased to share Fresno State's vision to make classes as accessible as possible. He also discussed the future opportunities for local students to achieve four year degrees at the Visalia campus.

HANFORD JOINT UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT:

A. District Ag Learning Lab - William Fishbough, Superintendent

Superintendent William Fishbough provided an update on the structural plans for the Agriculture Farm and provided a handout of the proposed site plan.

B. 2016 Bond Update - William Fishbough, Superintendent

Superintendent William Fishbough stated that the bond was approved by the voters in November in the amount of \$33,000,000. The Board will establish construction goals that may include a building for the library, career center, and administration at Sierra Pacific, as well as a swimming pool that will meet the needs and expectations to hold tournaments. Mr. Fishbough responded to questions and comments about future needs of a fourth high school, but believes they are years away before attendance will be high enough to move forward.
